Accreditation

Western Seminary is accredited by the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities (NWCCU). Accreditation of an institution of higher education by the NWCCU indicates that it meets or exceeds criteria for the assessment of institutional quality evaluated through a peer review process. An accredited college or university is one which has available the necessary resources to achieve its stated purposes through appropriate educational programs, is substantially doing so, and gives reasonable evidence that it will continue to do so in the foreseeable future. Institutional integrity is also addressed through accreditation.

Accreditation by the NWCCU is not partial but applies to the institution as a whole. As such, it is not a guarantee of every course or program offered, or the competence of individual graduates. Western Seminary is also a member of, and accredited by, the Commission on Accrediting of the Association of Theological Schools in the United States and Canada [ATS]. ATS is the accrediting body for theological schools and recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation and by the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Education.

The M.A. Counseling program in Clinical Mental Health Counseling at the Portland campus is accredited by the Council for Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs (CACREP), a specialized accrediting body recognized by the Council for Higher Education and by the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Education.

The seminary began in 1927 as Western Baptist Theological Seminary. In 1951 the name was changed to Western Conservative Baptist Theological Seminary, and in 1968 to Western Conservative Baptist Seminary. In 1996 the school name was changed to Western Seminary.

Assignment of Credit

Western Seminary operates on the early start semester calendar. There are three semesters per academic year: Fall, Spring and Summer.

Course Numbers

As of Summer 1980, all course numbers were changed to 500 level and above to more clearly reflect graduate level content. As of Fall 1985, all prefixes were changed to clarify the change to a semester system. 500 level courses are M.A./M.Div. level; 600 level courses are Th.M. level; 700 are D.Min./D.Miss. level. Course numbers below 500 are not considered graduate level credit.
